

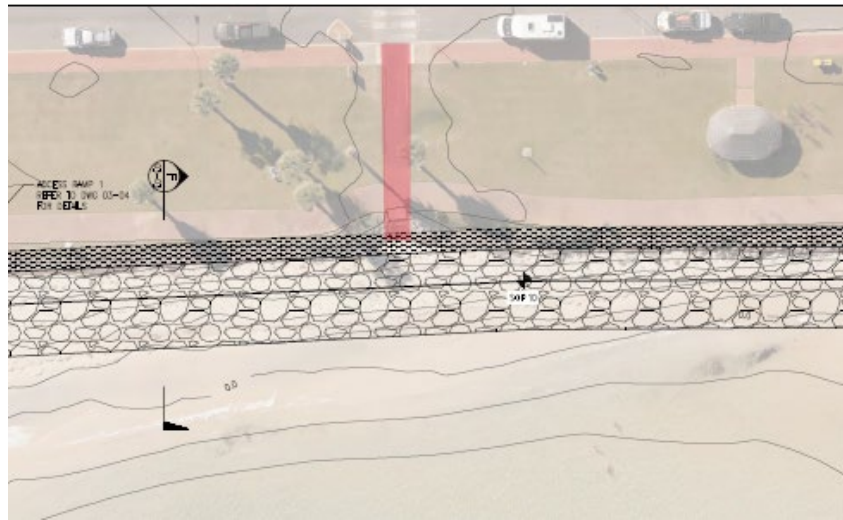
Questions

Drainage

- There is a culvert pipe protruding from the existing seawall at Work Area 1 (North). Is this live and does it need to be maintained / replaced as part of the works? If so, can you please provide dimensions / specifications. **Please see attached updated drawings which show the required treatment of the pipe protruding through the seawall. This pipe is to be extended to meet the requirements shown on the drawings.**

- There are two paved/ kerbed, accessways / open-drains in Work Area 2 (See below). These will no longer function with the proposed new revetment design. Is this the intended outcome? **The updated drawings note the requirement to locally modify the elevation of the seawall crest along the alignment of the two open drains to ensure that the drains continue to function.**



Stockpile of Material

- The drawings note existing seawall material is to be “Stockpiled for reuse”. For the Granite in Work Area 1 we assume that is reuse on the works; but for the “local limestone” material in Work Area 2, is this to be reused in the project or stockpiled for future Shire reuse elsewhere? **The intention is that all rock is reused for this project. This includes the limestone material that can be used as underlayer material provided it meets the specification.**

Footpath Specifications

- The works will result in damage to the waterfront coloured footpath in isolated areas. Can you please provide specification (thickness / concrete mix / colour / etc) for areas the contract will need to repair? **Any damage to the footpath will need to be repaired. The footpath is 2.7 m wide, 100 mm thick and does not include any reinforcing mesh. The colour of the footpath will need to be colour matched to the existing path.**
