Entry Restrictions	 Entrants must be under the age of 18 years as at 7 September 2024. Entrants must reside in either the Gascoyne, Mid-West or Pilbara regions of Western Australia. Entrants must submit for judging and if selected, perform their own original music (no covers accepted) and acknowledge any collaborators, having obtained their consent to release and perform this music. Entrants must have parental consent to enter this competition. Entrants must have a parent or guardian over the age of 25 to accompany them and supervise them during the event. Entrants must have three (3) original songs that if selected, can be performed live on stage within a fifteen (15) minute set.
Competition Period	Commences: 8.00 am AWST, Monday 22 July 2024 Ends: 11:59 pm AWST, Monday 12 August 2024
Entry Method	To enter, entrants must email their entries and music to cdo@sharkbay.wa.gov.au before the competition closes at 11:59pm on Monday 12 August, 2024.
Maximum Number of Entries	Artists may submit up to three tracks with their entry.
Judging Details	The winner will be chosen by a panel of Beats in the Bay experts. The winners will be picked based on their ability to deliver a good live performance, suitable for a Beats in the Bay Music Festival audience.
Prizes	Four Prize winners will win: (incl. GST) 1. An opportunity to perform at Beats in the Bay Music Festival Festival on Saturday 7 September 2024 in Shark Bay, WA. 2. A one off performance fee of \$500 3. A mentoring session with industry professionals 4. Up to \$1,500 towards travel and accommodation expenses to be agreed on determining the location of the winner. 5. Film and sound production of your performance.

Winner Notification	The winner will be notified by phone call in August 2024
Rights in Your Entry	Non-exclusive
Additional Terms Applicable to this Competition	As a winner, you will be representing Shire of Shark Bay at this event. As such you are obligated to behave responsibly and professionally and comply with the rules and requests that Shire of Shark Bay and the event organisers ask of you.



GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

In Introduction

- 1. By entering the Competition, you agree to be bound by the Terms and Conditions of the Competition. The Terms and Conditions governing the Competition include these General Terms and Conditions, the Schedule to these General Terms and Conditions and any other instructions relating to the Competition.
- 2. Any capitalised terms used in these General Terms and Conditions have the meaning given in the Schedule, unless stated otherwise. In the event of any inconsistency between the Schedule to the Terms and Conditions (Schedule) and these General Terms and Conditions, the Schedule will take precedence.
- 3. The Shire of Shark Bay may in its absolute discretion refuse to award any Prize to any entrant who fails to comply with these Terms and Conditions and reserves the right to refuse to allow the winner to take part in any part of the prize if it is deemed that it is not appropriate for the winner to take part in the prize for any reason.

Entry Restrictions

1. Eligibility to enter the Competition is subject to the Entry Restrictions. An entrant of the Competition must be an individual and not a company or organisation. Directors, immediate family members, employees and contractors of the Promoter and any agencies, retailers and suppliers directly associated with the Competition, or with the provision of the Prize, are not eligible to enter.

Competition Period

1. The Competition will be conducted during the Competition Period. Any entry received after the expiry of the Competition Period will be deemed invalid. No responsibility is accepted for late, lost, delayed or misdirected entries.

Entry Method

1. To enter the Competition, entrants must enter the Competition in accordance with the Entry Method (and any other entry details provided by the Promoter on the Website) during the Competition Period.

Maximum Number of Entries

1. Entrants can enter the Competition up to the Maximum Number of Entries. Entries must meet the requirements in the Schedule and are subject to the Entry Restrictions.

Judging Details

1. The entrant(s) whose entry is judged by the Promoter's panel of judges to be the most original and creative (and any judging criteria set out in Judging Details of the Schedule) will win one of four (4) Prizes. The Promoter and its panel of judges may, in their absolute discretion, decline to award any or all Prizes, including where the judges determine that the entry is not of publication standard. Chance plays no part in determining the Prize winners. Decisions of the Promoter and its panel of judges are final and will be binding on each person who enters the Competition and no correspondence will be entered into.

Prize

- 1. The Prizes will be awarded as specified in the Schedule. The Prize values for travel and accommodation expenses represent fair value for two people and are in Australian dollars and are correct as at the time of the commencement of the Competition Period. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for any variation in the Prize value.
- 2. The Prize winners must be accompanied and supervised at all times by a parent or legal guardian.
- 3. The performance fee and travel and accommodation are set amounts per selected act, regardless of member numbers (ie. solo act receives the same amount as a full band).



GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS (CON'T)

Prize Restrictions

- 1. Unless otherwise specified in the Schedule, the Promoter will not be responsible for any additional costs associated with use of the Prize. The Prize winner (and, if applicable, their guest(s)) are responsible for all costs associated with using the Prize including (if applicable) travel and/or transfer costs, expenses with respect to food and beverages, travel and medical insurance costs and spending money.
- 2. The Prize winner must be available to redeem the Prize on the dates stipulated by the Promoter. If the Prize winner is not able to redeem the Prize on that date, the Promoter may determine another Prize winner in its absolute discretion.
- 3. No component of the Prize can be transferred or redeemed for cash.
- 4. All Prizes are subject to availability. In the event that any of the Prizes or part of a Prize becomes unavailable due to circumstances beyond the Promoter's reasonable control, the Promoter reserves the right to provide a similar product to the same or greater value as the original prize, subject to any applicable laws or written directions made under applicable legislation.

Rights in Your Entry

Rights in Your Entry (continued from previous page)

- By submitting your entry to the Promoter, you grant the Promoter and its licensees and assignees:
 - 1. The Rights in Your Entry specified in the Schedule to exercise all rights in your entry, including without limitation, the right to reproduce and communicate your entry to the public in whole or in part, in perpetuity and throughout the world in any media; and
- 2.the right to publicise, broadcast and communicate to the public your name, character, likeness or voice for any promotion or matter incidental to the Competition with no compensation to you for such use.
- 4. You understand and agree that your entry may be edited or adapted at any time by the Promoter for legal, editorial or operational reasons.
- 5. As a condition of accepting the Prize, the winner must sign any legal documentation as and in the form required by the Promoter and/or Prize suppliers in their absolute discretion, including but not limited to a legal release and indemnity form.
