



Memorial Plaques

The Shire of Shark Bay has a Local Law in regard to the placement, materials used and size of plaques placed in the Cemetery. Persons who intend to place a memorial plaque must make application to the Shire prior to installation.

The conditions that apply are as follows:

- 1) All memorial plaques placed in a memorial plaque section of the cemetery shall –
 - a. Be made of admiralty bronze or any other material approved by the Board and
 - b. Not be less than the dimensions 380 mm x 280 mm, nor more than 560 mm x 305 mm, and
- 2) All memorial plaques made of admiralty bronze shall –
 - a. Not exceed 20 mm in thickness, and
 - b. Be placed upon a base mounting approved by the board.
- 3) All memorial plaques made of stone shall –
 - a. Not exceed 50mm in thickness placed upon a mounting approved by the Board, or
 - b. Not be less than 100mm thickness if it is not to be placed upon a base mounting.
- 4) Approval of application and payment of applicable fees must be made prior to beginning work or requesting fabrication of plaque from chosen supplier.
